SHIP'S ROUTINE - Carry out the daily routine at sea/at anchor w/troops embarked as prescribed in TRAVERSE COUNTY INST 5330.1A, except as modified below:

- 0330 - Reveille. Station the Special Sea Detail - bow anchor.
- ~~0400~~ - Anchor in assault anchorage, Navplion, Greece. Lower LCVP & LCPL to rail
- 0415 - Land the Landing Force. Away all boats. Dispatch 3 LCVP's to USS Mountrail to load on-call serial 713. Lower bow ramp. Receive serial 704 (125 Marines) from USS Mountrail via 4 LCVP's. Breakfast for AMTRAC personnel.
- ~~0500~~ - Breakfast for USS Mountrail Marine personnel.
- 0515 - Simulate loading LVT's. Set Condition 1A. Battle dress required for deck and repair party personnel.
- 0545 - Splash 10 LVT's for Wave I.
- ~~0550~~ - Secure from Condition 1A.
- ~~0600~~ - H-Hour. Wave I touchdown. Lower truck ramp. Move designated Marine vehicles from tank deck to main deck. Lower accommodation ladder. Breakfast for the crew.
- - Breakfast for Marine personnel.
- - Transfer serial 704 to USS Mountrail via 4 LCVP's.
- 0730 - Muster on station.
- ~~0800~~ - Receive USS Mountrail LCM 6 alongside to load Marine Recon Detail. When completed, turn to - commence ship's work.
- 1045 - Mess gear.
- 1100 - Early dinner for cooks and messcooks.
- 1130 - Early dinner for watch reliefs.
- 1145 - Knock off ship's work. Dinner for the crew.
- 1230 - Dinner for troops.
- 1300 - Turn to - continue ship's work.
- 1430 - Station the Special Sea Detail - bow anchor. Set Condition Zebra second deck and below.
- 1500 - Underway to close beach to load LVT's. Upon completion return to assigned anchorage.
- - Fuel diesel tanker to 400 gallons.
- 1545 - Mess gear.
- 1630 - Knock off ship's work. Supper for cooks and messcooks.
- 1700 - Supper for the crew. Check setting of Material Condition YOKE.
- 1730 - Supper for the troops.
- 1830 - Sweepers.
- 1945 - Duty division rig for movies.

1. The ship will remain at anchor tonight and participate in another pre-dawn landing tomorrow. We will be in the Navplion area until next Monday, 16 Sep.

2. COMPHIBRON TWO will conduct a PMS inspection aboard Traverse County on Friday, 13 September 1968.

3. Two pairs of eyeglasses have been found. The owners can claim them from the Chief Master-at-Arms.
